



DRUG TOXICOLOGY SCREENING TESTS

All samples submitted to the Arizona Department of Public Safety Crime Laboratory for drug toxicology are first screened by Enzyme Linked Immunosorbent Assay (ELISA). The list below represents the routine drug panels and drugs that will be screened.

Drug Recognition Experts (DREs) - Please list your DRE opinion(s) on the Scientific Examination Request forms and include a copy of the DRE evaluation face sheet. DRE opinions of Central Nervous System Depressants, Narcotic Analgesics, and Dissociative Anesthetics will move forward to a more comprehensive General Basics Screen if the ELISA preliminary screen is negative.

Additional Cases - Cases involving children, officers (e.g., officer involved shooting), sexual assault, or fatalities, will receive a General Basics Screen in addition to the ELISA preliminary screen. Sexual assault urine cases will further be tested for benzodiazepines. For a list of potential drugs covered in the General Basics Screen see the **Drug Toxicology Confirmation Tests** documents.

Important Note - If a drug is suspected other than the ones listed below, or if a drug appears within a parenthesis () below, it **must** be listed on the Scientific Examination Request form to ensure the proper analysis will be performed.
